

INFORMED CONSENT

For all manuscripts that include details, or images relating to individual participants, written informed consent for the publication of these must be obtained from the owner of the animal/participant and a statement to this effect should appear in the manuscript. If the participant has died, then consent for publication must be sought from the next of kin of the participant. Documentation showing consent for publication must be made available to the Editor on request, and will be treated confidentially. In cases where images are unidentifiable and there are no details on individuals reported within the manuscript, consent for publication of images may not be required. The final decision on whether consent to publish is required lies with the Editor (Informed Consent Template).
